Home health agencies provide skilled nursing, physical therapy, occupational therapy, speech therapy, and medical social services in a patient's home. These services are typically ordered by a physician and may be covered by Medicare or Medi-Cal for eligible individuals.

Examples of Services:

- Skilled nursing
- Rehabilitation therapies
- Chronic disease management
- Home health aide assistance
- Monitoring post-hospitalization recovery
